Meet: Intersection of Regents Road/Lahitte Ct., South University City. From intersection of Governor & Regents, go north on Regents two blocks to dead end. Ample parking available.

Bring: Binoculars if you have them (we'll have extras you can borrow); water and sunscreen.

Spring is the best time of year to see and hear a great variety of birds in Rose Canyon, including resident and migratory species. They are in breeding plumage, some with spectacular colors, and sing to establish territories and attract mates. Join us to experience this dramatic annual display of nature in our midst.
